Hyde Park plans open house on Oct. 19, ribbon cutting on Oct. 20

HYDE PARK, N.Y. >> The Town of Hyde Park will hold an open house on Oct. 19 for residents to comment on the planning for a future town center and a ribbon cutting on Oct. 20 celebrating the completion of the first phase of sidewalk improvements.

Both are components of the Hyde Park Downtown Initiative, which aims to support redevelopment of the commercial district along Route 9 through planning and infrastructure investment. Information on the initiative is at HPDowntown.com.

The open house will take place at 6:30 p.m. at Hyde Park Town Hall, 4383 Albany Post Road, and will give residents a chance to see plans for the commercial center of the town.

The ribbon cutting will be at 5 p.m. outside the Hyde Park Antique Center at 4192 Albany Post Road and will celebrate the completion of the first phase of the sidewalk improvements along U.S. Route 9.

The sidewalk project spans a half-mile from Terwilliger Lane to Park Plaza.
