

Town of Hyde Park seeks names of veterans

The Town of Hyde Park is working to ensure that veterans who have served their country are duly recognized.


Town of Hyde Park Supervisor Aileen Rohr asked town board member David Ray and historian Barbara Hobens to look into compiling a list of any names missing on the memorial plaques at town hall to ensure that everyone who has served in the armed services is rightfully credited, according to a written release



At a meeting with veteran Michael Athanas, they decided to reach out in print, on Facebook and by spreading the word to civic organizations, churches, and school reunion committees. A few names have been identified from the Vietnam War (Nov. 1, 1955-April 30, 1975).

The memorial plaques at Hyde Park Town Hall list the men and women from Hyde Park who were killed in action and those who were on active duty and served during "times of conflict" as defined by Congress.
