Hyde Park pedestrian plan focus of March 28 meeting

HYDE PARK >> The Hyde Park Town Board will be host an informational meeting at 7 p.m. Monday, March 28, at Town Hall, 4383 Albany Post Road, to discuss the “Route 9 Pedestrian Improvement Project,” which seeks to create a “Main Street” feel on U.S. Route 9 by adding sidewalks and crosswalks, and creating a landscaped green buffer on the east side of Route 9 from Water Tower Road to Park Plaza.

Representatives of Greenman-Pedersen Engineering and town officials will give a short presentation and provide an opportunity for residents and property owners to examine the draft plans and ask questions.

The plan, developed with the state Department of Transportation, is a result of years of work, including the 2006 Department of Transportation Corridor Study and the 2012 Hyde Park Walks Pedestrian Study. For more information, call Supervisor Aileen Rohr at (845) 229-5111, ext. 8.
