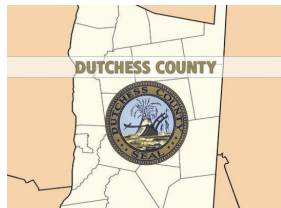


Hyde Park Town Board to hold public meeting on Route 9 Pedestrian Improvement Project

HYDE PARK - An informational meeting on the Route 9 Pedestrian Improvement Project will be held Monday, March 28 at Hyde Park Town Hall.

During the meeting, hosted by the Hyde Park Town Board, officials will discuss the project which looks to create a "Main Street" feel on Route 9 through Hyde Park with the use of sidewalks and landscaping, according to a release from the town.

The plan also incorporates new highway signage and pedestrian crosswalks on the east side of Route 9 from Water Tower Road to Park Plaza.

Town representatives and project designers will provide a presentation about the project before opening the floor to questions and comments.

The meeting will be held at 4383 Albany Post Road in Hyde Park at 7 p.m.
