Some Hyde Park property owners will be getting a check

HYDE PARK >> Landowners in the town of Hyde Park who owned property in the Harbour Hills Water District through 2002 will be getting a check in the mail.

The town transferred the original Harbour Hills Water District to the Dutchess County Water and Wastewater Authority in 2002, but the district was not dissolved and monies remained in a savings account for the owners of the parcels who were members of the district at the time of the transfer.

The Town Board, after extensive research, has finally been able to formally dissolve the district and return these monies to the owners of the properties that were part of the district at the time of transfer in 2002.

That means that those residents who currently own those properties that were part of the original district will be receiving a check for approximately \$500 in the next few days, officials said.
